A strong endowment is critical. It ensures that we can offer a comprehensive secondary education program that is financially feasible for families, without a reliance on consistently increasing tuition. 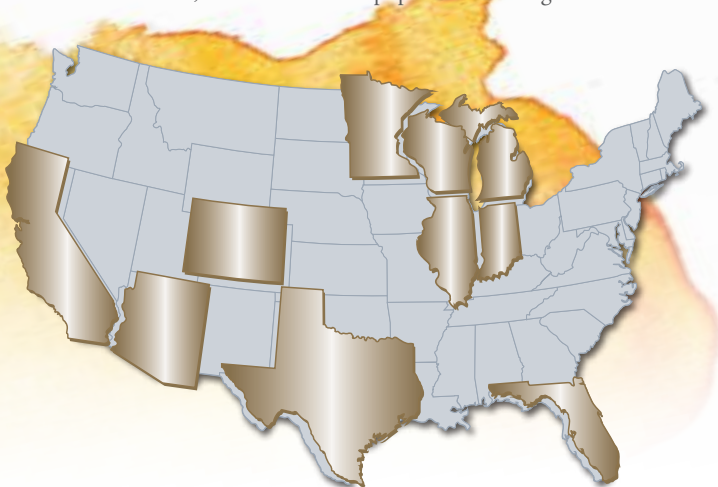

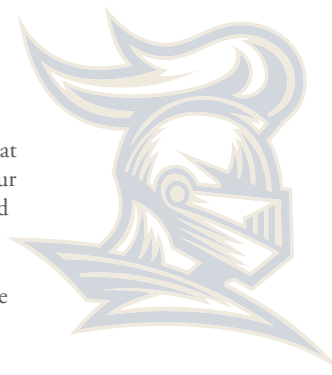
Congratulations to the graduating Class of 2018, who collectively earned \$9.8 Million in college scholarships and awards. 100% of the class of 2018 is continuing their education.

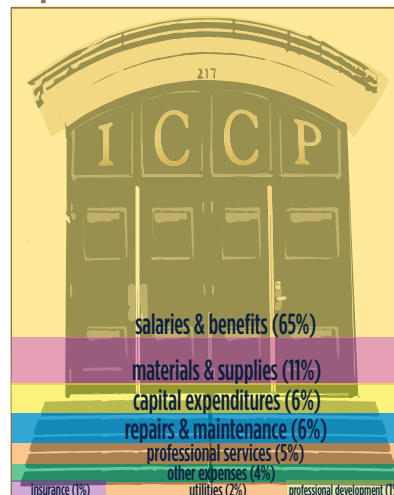
